7. Head of School Report

Head of School, Randy Rodriguez, shared that MVCA is amid state testing. MVCA's goal is to have at least 95% of students complete the state tests. He shared the story of four families and their unique circumstances and how MVCA is supporting them.

a. Multi-Tiered Systems of Support Framework

MVCA's Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) Coordinator, Heidi Gray, shared that this framework is designed to meet the needs of all the students including academic, behavioral, and social and emotional learning needs. MTSS is a tiered infrastructure that uses data to help support students. Tier 1 includes universal support and instruction for all students. Tier 2 includes targeted support and Tier 3 is more intensive support. Staff can identify the needs of students to determine the best mode of support. Additional support includes special programs, the student support system, and WIN (What I Need) sessions. Through MTSS, MVCA and staff support more students beyond Tier 1 instruction. There are many preventative MTSS support at the Tier 1 level such as SEL homeroom lessons, Stride tutoring, student clubs, supplemental Math and Reading Programs, and support for MKV families. The Student Support Team includes structure support for learning coaches. Mrs. Gray explained that MVCA uses an evaluation tool, Self-Assessment of MTSS (SAM) to evaluate areas of strengths and areas of

improvement. There are 42 items that are evaluated. Staff continue to have discussions and review data for effective implementation of MTSS.
